Safety Inspection Information Potomac Speedway

Safety must be checked by Potomac Speedway officials prior to your first race. If you are not present during safety inspections the first few weeks, it <u>is your responsibility to ask an official to have your car checked.</u>

<u>ROLL CAGES:</u> verify the rules on the website for your class and make sure it is correct. Any questions – please ask.

HELMETS: MUST be Snell Approved. It MUST have a certification sticker – SA2015 or SA2020. All SA2010 helmets expired 1/1/2022. No DOT helmets.

SEATBELTS: Technically do not have a expiration date but RECOMMENDED to be replaced every 2 years. Any tears, rips, holes, or frays must be replaced immediately.

<u>WINDOW NETS:</u> Are absolutely required for anything that is not a late model. Same rules apply for these as seatbelts.

RACE SUITS: Technically do not have an expiration date but should be recertified by the company every 5 years. No rips, holes, etc.

SEATS: Must be aluminum and properly bolted. ABSOLUTELY no plastic or fiberglass. Full containment is HIGHLY recommended.

SHOES & GLOVES: Highly recommended but not technically required.

SAFETY CHAINS: Street, Hobby, Strictly, UC, and Roadsters for towing purposes.
